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## STUDENT \& CAREGIVER EXPECTATIONS

Daily wellness checks of students before sending to school. Students with temperatures of $100^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ or higher must stay home until fever free for 24 hours (without use of any medication to control fever) and no less than 10 days from symptom onset.

Maintain one location for school transportation (pick-up and drop-off). Students will not be permitted to ride the bus other than the one they are normally assigned.

Students should not arrive to their building before 8:15am.

Frequent hand washing and sanitizing throughout the school day will be required.

Covering all coughs/sneezes with a tissue or inside of elbow.

Ensuring appropriate physical distance from others whenever possible.

Students may assist in daily wiping/cleaning of desks and chairs at end of school day, or as requested.

Students will have access to water bottle filling stations. Regular drinking fountains will not be accessible.

Ensure there are multiple, pre-arranged methods of getting a student home from school should they become ill or exhibit symptoms.

## STAFF/SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

Daily wellness self-check of all staff members. Staff members with temperatures of $100^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ or higher must stay home until fever free for 24 hours (without use of any medication to control fever) and no less than 10 days from symptom onset.

Frequent hand washing and sanitizing throughout the school day will be required.

Arrange desks in classrooms to provide social distancing of students and eliminate unnecessary furniture.

Provide reminders to students of good hygiene practices, physical distancing, and contacting caregivers if repeated issues arise.

Eliminate shared classroom materials as much as possible.

Keep the classroom door open to maximize airflow and to reduce the need to touch door handles.

Ensure classrooms are stocked with supplies needed for daily cleaning and wiping of surfaces frequently.

Frequent cleaning and disinfecting of common areas and high-touch surfaces (door handles, handrails, toilets, counters, sinks, etc.).

Ensure proper signs are posted in hallways, restrooms, and common areas with messaging on social distancing, hand hygiene, staying home when sick, etc.

School staff will be responsible for any disinfecting or sanitizing. (Students can be involved in cleaning, but not disinfecting or sanitizing due to chemicals.)

Refer to school nurse for a wellness check for any student exhibiting any symptoms.

The school nurse will correspond with staff and families information on Covid 19 symptoms.

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## CLASSROOMS/SPECIALTY CLASSROOMS

## Classroom movement will be

 minimized when feasible.Classrooms will be set up to allow for as much physical distancing as possible and not clustered without facing each other without proper dividers.

Students will be expected to have their own supplies. Shared supplies will be eliminated as feasible.

Student locker usage may be minimized requiring students to carry materials throughout the day.

Classrooms will be stocked with supplies needed for daily cleaning of surfaces and personal sanitizing (tissues, hand sanitizer etc.)

Classroom doors will be open as often as possible to maximize air flow and reduce the need to touch door handles.

Classrooms will be cleaned frequently.

Facial covering will be recommended, or required, if close staff/student or student/student interaction will last longer than 10-15 minutes.

Travel to Specialty Classrooms will be eliminated when feasible.

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## SCHOOL OFFICES

Barriers will be installed between the staff and the customers/students to help ensure the health and safety.

Staff will wear a facial covering when in close proximity (less than 6ft.) for prolonged periods of time (15 minutes or more).

Cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer will be readily available.

## Student sign out/sign in: For

 students who need to leave early or arrive late, the district will be using the same method that many doctors offices have been using.- Parents are to call the office when they are in the E.S. driveway, M.S. parking lot, H.S. parking lot, or and the office will either come get the students (for arriving late) or escort the student to the door (for leaving early).

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## SCHOOL/CLASSROOM LIBRARIES

A mobile library system will be in place for students in K-5.

Books may be distributed to students, but upon returning books to the library they should be physically quarantined for 3 days ( 72 hours) before being re-shelved and placed back into distribution, if taken out of the building.

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## HALLWAYS I COMMON AREAS

Students and staff will be discouraged from congregating in close proximity of one another.

Students will have access to water bottle filling stations.
Regular drinking fountains will not be accessible.

When feasible:

- Dismissal times during the school day(class changes, lunch, recess, etc.) will be staggered to ensure physical distancing.
- A one way flow of traffic will be utilized.
- Doors will be kept open to discourage high touch points.

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## PARENTTTEACHER CONFERENCES AND MEETIMGS

When possible, meetings will be conducted virtually or via phone.

In person meetings will be conducted in an area large enough to allow for physical distancing, including the use of masks.

Conference areas will be stocked with tissues and hand sanitizer.

Meeting attendees are to sanitize and wash hands before and after meetings.

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
